### Athlete Scholar of the Year Scholarship Application

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### USJF ATHLETE-SCHOLAR OF THE YEAR AWARD RULES AND ELIGIBILITY FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2023-2024

(Please read through all 6 pages of this form)

The United States Judo Federation Board of Directors has established the "USJF Athlete-Scholar of the Year Award." First prize is \$1,000.00, second prize \$750.00, and third prize \$500.00. The money will be paid directly to the accredited post-secondary academic entity, including trade school, technical college, graduate school, college or university of their choice at the time of matriculation.

The high school/college year of this contest extends from September 2023 through June 2024 and consists of any two continuous semesters. One semester may be from high school and the other from college. The contestant must submit a <a href="school transcript(s">school transcript(s)</a>, which includes a list of courses taken, a letter or numerical grade for each course and his or her grade point average. <a href="Report cards will NOT">Report cards will NOT</a> <a href="beaccepted">be accepted</a>. The degree of difficulty of each course will be considered. A high or even the highest G.P.A. will not ensure a win. The Judoka's personal letter of extracurricular activities, Judo history, effect of Judo on their life, and the Head Instructor's character endorsement will be considered. The applicant must be a current regular USJF member in good standing and have been a member of the USJF continuously during the two previous Fiscal Years; so, a minimum of three (3) annual continuous membership years. He or she must have entered and competed in 3 USJF sanctioned events from September 2023 through June 2024. <a href="The completed application must be in the USJF National Office (PO Box 338 • Ontario, OR. 97914-0338) by July 31, 2024.">2024</a>. Faxes (541-889-5836 or 541-508-4203) and Adobe Acrobat documents via e-mail (no@usjf.com) are also acceptable means of submission. High School, Post – Secondary, and college students only may apply. Grade equivalency scores are:

A = 4.0	A = 3.6	B+ = 3.4	B = 3.0	B - = 2.6
C = 2.0	$C_{-} = 1.6$	D+ = 1.4	D = 1.0	D - = 0.6

A minimum G.P.A. of a "B" (3.000 on 4.000 based system) is required. Only applicants with G.P.A.s of 3.000 or greater will be in the final pool. The final pool may contain both female and male contestants. The personal letter of extracurricular activities, Judo history, effect of Judo on their life, and the Head Instructor's character endorsement will determine the winner. Persons who have won a USJF Athlete-Scholar award in the past may compete again.

The ASOY Committee has the option to schedule an interview with the Applicant. The ASOY Committee's decisions will be final.

The winners will be announced August 15, 2024 via the USJF Website and other official USJF communication. *Please complete all information required on pages 2, 3, 4, & 5 of this form.*
